SHOULD YOU HAVE A PATERNITY TEST?

If you answer yes to any of the following questions you should consider having a paternity test:

1. Do you have any reason whatsoever to believe the child may not be yours?

4. Were you and the mother having relationship problems during the period that she became pregnant?
5. Did the mother leave your relationship without telling you that she was pregnant?
6. Was pressure applied to you to sign paternity documents prior to the birth?
7. Have others told you that you are not the father?
8. Did the mother make false accusations about domestic violence, sexual assault, or child abuse and get a protective order keeping you from the child(ren).

WHAT IS PATERNITY FRAUD?

Paternity Fraud, also known as “Child Identity Theft”, is a promiscuous or unfaithful woman surreptitiously naming the wrong man, or non-biological father, the father of her child(ren).

1. There can be dozens or more victims from just one incident: the child(ren), the biological father, the falsely named father, their families of choice, and the extended families of all involved.

2. Victims of paternity fraud and Child Identity Theft may be denied rightful inheritance rights, social security benefits, military benefits, and other rights and benefits associated with biological parentage.

3. Paternity fraud and Child Identity Theft can lead to violence, divorce, imprisonment of the "Duped Dad," bankruptcy of the wrongly identified man, and even suicide from the trauma.

HOW COMMON IS PATERNITY FRAUD?

No one knows for sure, but the Blood Bank Association of America found that just under 30% of the paternity tests they conducted were negative, almost one out of three! Research shows anywhere from 2.5% to well over 30% of fathers are wrongfully named, including in 18% of births in marriages; or, 1 out of five children born into marriages may not be the child of the husband!

PATERNITY FRAUD AND THE MILITARY

Military personnel are particularly susceptible to paternity fraud, particularly when on extended tours of duty. The military offers tax-free housing allowances, extensive medical benefits, life insurance, retirement benefits and base discounts. Military personnel cannot adequately defend themselves when on extended tours of duty and upon return home may find their rights have been jeopardized.

WHAT IS PATERNITY TESTING?

Paternity testing is a process through which biological fatherhood is conclusively determined or excluded. All of us have unique inherited DNA (DeoxyriboNucleic Acid) from which questionable paternity (maternity, sibling relations, infidelity, and other relationships) can be resolved.

PaternityFraudDNA offers DNA testing services to determine paternity, maternity, identical or fraternal twins, siblings, and other relationships. PaternityFraudDNA tests normally involve painless non-invasive swab tests, though we can process blood, hair, bone samples (teeth, femur, other bone), arrange for complete “Family Reconstruction Studies” with an approved PhD, and conduct “Y-Chromosome” tests for two males. We can even arrange to “bank” your DNA in a secure facility.

WHERE CAN I GET A PATERNITY TEST?

PaternityFraudDNA testing services are available in virtually every state in the US and many countries.

CAN I TAKE THE TEST AT HOME?

Yes, there are two basic methods for taking the tests:

Home Tests: Home tests are mailed to you. You conduct the test in total privacy. Home tests are used by those who “just want to know”. However, we strongly recommend using the Private Collection method.

Private Collection Tests: Private Collection tests involve an objective third party who takes the DNA samples and begins to establish a legal chain of evidence. Private Collection tests are necessary when related legal action is contemplated or in progress. Home test results cannot be used to legally establish or disestablish paternity. If you use a Home test then need a Private Collection test you will pay twice, and Private Collections are confidential too outside the legal process.
